Overview:

Manage the Fire Protection program for C&S and ES3 warehouses, offices and retail store affiliates. Oversee code compliance and physical implementation of new and existing fire protection and fire alarm systems. Provide functional and technical knowledge required to maintain systems compliance with NFPA, state, local, federal and insurance requirements. Conduct training for maintenance and warehouse personnel of the fire protection and fire alarm systems.

Responsibilities:

- Review design specifications, technical requirements and scope of work for fire protection installations and renovations. Manage fire protection installations and renovations to ensure that cost effective measures are taken and code compliance is adhered to. Coordinate all capital projects related to fire protection systems including suppression and alarm systems. Work collaboratively with property insurance companies, engineers and local/state fire agencies to ensure compliance. Provide budgetary project estimates. Estimation will include meeting with existing and new vendors to obtain estimates for projects, insuring that scope of work is in line with project initiatives and applicable codes.
- Plan, schedule and execute annual week long fire protection training class for maintenance personnel. Coordinate onsite training of Operations, Safety and Maintenance personnel to coincide with insurance inspections. Provide ongoing high level training to Regional Maintenance Directors.
- Manage the C&S fire protection program. Develop and refine the C&S fire protection program for annual compliance testing and fire alarm monitoring. Prepare annual request for proposal, bid out services to national vendors, tabulate bids and execute contracts. Develop annual inspection schedule with vendors and manage vendors to insure all inspections are completed as required by insurance carrier and local/state/federal regulations.
- Coordinate insurance inspection schedules with provider for all C&S and ES3 facilities. Attend all inspections to support local maintenance personnel. Assist in preparing responses to insurance recommendations including scheduling and managing projects as required for compliance.
- Assist other Facilities personnel with projects containing fire protection scopes of work.
- Aid in the development of corporate wide fire protection design and construction standards.
- Help analyze new business ventures by assisting in developing conceptual building plans and budgetary construction estimates.
- Assist the maintenance department on large, capital intensive maintenance projects.
