A. GENERAL SUMMARY OF POSITION:

Under general direction of EHS Director, responsible for academic and research safety services in the areas of biological, radiological and chemical use laboratory practices. Also responsible for overseeing industrial hygiene matters for the campus at large. Serves as the primary EHS contact with the Office of Research and Engagement regarding safety, health and compliance issues related to facilities such as BL3 and vivarium and to satisfy funding agencies such as NIH, CDC, USDA and DOD. May serve as Acting EHS Director in the absence of Director.

B. EXAMPLES OF DUTIES: (Identify those duties that demand the greatest amount of time, attention, and are of key priority to the department. Include any duties which present unusual physical requirements such as standing, walking, and exposure to chemicals, etc.)

1. Oversees the provision of biological, radiological, laboratory chemical, and industrial hygiene services to the campus community that are aimed at complying with all applicable federal and state environmental regulations.
2. Oversees the Chemical Environmental Management System [CEMS] program including the lab assessment component.
3. Serves as the primary contact with the Executive Area of Research and Engagement regarding safety and health requirements of granting agencies including but not limited to NIH, CDC, USDA, DHS, DPH and DOD.

4. Serve as appointed by Vice Chancellor for Research and Engagement on Institutional Compliance Committees such as IBC, IACUC, RUC and ICSC and provides appropriate protocol reviews
5. Assists the Executive Area of Research and Engagement in obtaining and maintaining certifications for Laboratory Animal Care programs including AAALAC certification
6. Networks with other universities and related consortiums to promote more effective means of achieving regulatory compliance.
7. Performs administrative tasks complimenting departmental mission: establish short and long term goals, compile monthly/annual reports, monthly news articles, participates in departmental policy formation, and is knowledgeable in specialized laboratory safety related software applications.
8. Provides guidance and technical services to the university community for area of responsibility.
9. Provides emergency response (including off hours) for events that involve area of program responsibility to protect the campus community and comply with regulatory requirements.
10. Advises governmental or other health and safety personnel responding to emergencies.

EHS Manager (Northeastern OH) for two chemical plants totaling about 500 employees. This position will report to the Site Manager and have several direct reports. The ideal candidate will have 10+ years ehs experience (focus on safety), staff management experience, knowledge of PSM, VPP and ISO experience and a BS in Safety, Environmental Science or related.

Regional EHS Manager (Northern IL) for 3 food manufacturing plants consisting of approximately 300 employees (union). This position will report to the Director of Safety at the Corporate Parent and have no direct reports. There will also be dotted line to the 3 Plant Managers. The focus of this position will be safety although knowledge of environmental is required. Ideally the person will have 5+ years safety/environmental experience in a manufacturing environment with some multi-site experience and a BS in Safety/Environmental or related. The candidate should have 5+ years of ehs experience out of manufacturing to include iso 14001, rcra and emergency response training and a BS in Safety/Environmental or related. Director EHS (South AR) for two manufacturing sites of this company consisting of approximately 400 employees; both union and non-union facilities. This person will report to the Plant Manager at the Arkansas site and have 8 direct reports. This person

This position will develop standards, guidelines and tools to meet external regulations and internal EH&S requirements. The incumbent will partner with EH&S personnel and other key managers to drive and facilitate compliance, and meet other corporate and business goals.

Additionally, this person will provide IH consultation or analytical services to the business to support both operational and product stewardship needs for Aspen's products and registration.

Major Duties:

- Partner with the management team to drive and facilitate compliance, and meet other corporate and business goals
- Lead or participate in EH&S audits.
- Provide IH requirement interpretations, consultation and training as requested by specific facilities or businesses.
- Summarize and interpret IH monitoring data for businesses and facilities
- Participate in incident investigations and corrective action process.
- Participate in capital project reviews
- Assist with regulatory inspections or compliance actions
- Understand and coach others on the use of the IH processes relating to exposure monitoring
- Must be familiar with relevant regulatory requirements
- Ability to guide the implementation of EH&S specific programs and processes related to the field of exposure monitoring
- Ability to develop findings and recommendations based on the analysis of IH data
- Can apply Root Cause Analysis methodology and incident investigation processes as needed
- Able to support qualitative and quantitative exposure assessment process by being knowledgeable of process and process tools
- Other Duties:
- Provide consultation to external customers relating to IH exposure monitoring

- Coordinate data gathering and interpretation for litigation, epidemiology, insurance needs for facilities and businesses.
- Conduct special product testing related to health and safety, as requested by the business
- Ability to recognize opportunities for process enhancements and clarifications as it relates to exposure monitoring by remaining knowledgeable on up-to-date techniques and methodologies
- Develop and maintain IH work processes, standards, procedures, training, and other tools
- Develop methods and techniques for recognition, evaluation and control of occupational health risks.
- Develop the know-how (processes, training, job aids, etc.) for meeting regulatory and requirements
- Identify opportunities to streamline IH resources and work processes relating to exposure monitoring
- Serve as the subject matter expert for one or more technical focal point areas
- Ability to apply specific technical expertise in the development of methods for IH risk evaluation and control
- Ability to understand manufacturing processes and related chemistry
- Can write technical information in a manner suitable for the targeted audience
- Understands interactions between IH and other EH&S requirements
- Can assist in budget planning and apply budgetary controls
- Preferred Skills/Experience:
- Candidate must be able to handle a variety of tasks simultaneously and must be able to prioritize work to meet deadlines.
- Strong written and oral communications skills are necessary, as this position requires interaction with various levels of management, as well as interaction with government agencies.
