This position will coordinate efforts with operations management to provide risk assessments to identified focused safety concerns. Assists senior management with data analysis and project implementation designed to meet regional and departmental goals.

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Regulatory Compliance
 - Stays current with regulatory compliance issues (OSHA, MSHA, DOT) and recommends changes in policy and operation to meet regulations
 - Provides on site assistance to Operations Management during regulatory audits
 - Develops relationships with regulatory agencies for the purpose of ensuring compliance and positive working partnerships with agencies
 - Coordinates audits and inspections with regulatory agencies as required

 - Provides information on facility issues which require significant repair expenditures; makes recommendations for process changes to ensure safe operation until repair can be made
