Reports to: Health, Safety & Environmental Manager

Responsible to develop, implement and maintain programs designed to ensure the safety of the workforce with the goal of eliminating personal injury and vehicle accidents. This position will coordinate efforts with operations management to provide risk assessments to identified focused safety concerns. Assists senior management with data analysis and project implementation designed to meet regional and departmental goals.

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Regulatory Compliance
 - Stays current with regulatory compliance issues (OSHA, MSHA, DOT) and recommends changes in policy and operation to meet regulations
 - Provides on site assistance to Operations Management during regulatory audits
 - Develops relationships with regulatory agencies for the purpose of ensuring compliance and positive working partnerships with agencies
 - Coordinates audits and inspections with regulatory agencies as required
 - Develops and implements policies and procedures for the specific risks associated with the Product Line
 - Ensures that each facility maintains accurate written program documentation that meets regulatory standards and is understandable to field personnel

 - Develops and delivers specific training programs for all operations employees including technical and compliance specific topics
 - Makes issue specific videos to address safety issues and topics affecting the region
 - Develops Toolbox Talk programs for Product Line and assists in delivery of programs as requested
 - Analyzes accident details and investigations to assist in developing preventative actions for future operations
- Audits/Inspections
 - Performs behavioral audits and facility inspections on all facilities associated with the Product Line on a regular basis; follows up to insure issues have been corrected
 - Provides information on facility issues which require significant repair expenditures; makes recommendations for process changes to ensure safe operation until repair can be made

- Consults with Product Line General Manager on safety performance of the Product Line; recommends changes in policy, procedure and training needs to improve safety performance
- Actively participates in Product Line Safety Committees as assigned
- Provides field service and support to Operations Management
- Assists Operations Management with accident investigation for all lost time and vehicle accidents
- Recommends changes in work processes or procedures to ensure safety of personnel
- Program and Project Implementation
 - Participates in implementing the Fatality Prevention Effort Program within the region.
