Duties & Responsibilities

- Leads the development and management of environmental programs, procedures and documentation to ensure compliance with Federal, State and local regulations including air pollution, water pollution, hazardous/universal waste, spill prevention and control, pollution prevention, storage tanks, waste transportation, emergency response and related programs.
- Develops evaluates, recommends & implements policies & procedures to assure awareness of, & implementation with air, water, waste management & related environmental requirements.
- Conducts strategic regulatory analysis to identify risks and risk mitigation strategies.
- Ensures that management, communications and quality control systems are implemented to inspect, monitor, assess, & guide the actions of EHSEM environmental engineers, operational staff & clients including University compliance officers, building & project managers, lab personnel, contractors & others.
- Provides client services through a program of training, inspections, permit assistance, compliance reporting, technical evaluations, management systems development & similar functions.
- Manages activities of environmental staff, consultants & contractors.
- Reviews planned expansion, modification or closure of facilities for environmental implications.
- Maintains expert knowledge of existing & proposed environmental regulations, develops compliance strategies;
- Strong Clean Air Act and RCRA expertise preferred, ability to independently interpret & apply environmental requirements to client needs.
- Provides leadership direction to management, technical and operational staff in the EHSEM environmental unit.
- Develops and implements environmental compliance training programs for University personnel. .
- Manages a decentralized hazardous waste and air quality program.
- Conducts annual assessment of Harvard's environmental programs to identify and control significant hazards and risks.

- Conducts audits of vendors performing environmental services including wastewater, air quality, pest control, hazardous waste inspection, packaging, transportation, disposal. and vendor's emergency response program.
- Establishes and leads internal committees, workgroups and networks to communicate environmental program requirements and strategies to others in the University.
- Maintains liaison with regulatory agencies, other institutions and industry colleagues to enhance the quality of environmental programs at the University.
- Prepares and/or reviews regulatory compliance reports, regulatory summaries and required compliance program plans and documentation.

Basic Qualifications

- Must have B.S. in Environmental Science, Engineering or Chemical Engineering. Must have expert knowledge of Federal, State and local environmental regulations. Minimum of 5 years experience in staff supervision, minimum 10 years experience in the development, implementation, oversight & monitoring of multimedia environmental compliance programs within a large organization. Requires outstanding written, verbal, presentation & computer skills.
- Ability to perform in a fast-paced, highly diverse, multi-disciplinary team environment. Demonstrated proficiency in development and use of databases.
- Expertise in Microsoft Office products, including Word, Access, Excel, Outlook, MS Project and PowerPoint. Must attain expertise in use of other common scheduling and communications software in use at Harvard.

Special Requirements

- Participates in EHSEM Emergency Response Program on rotating basis, as a cross-trained EH&S staff member, will be required to carry a pager and respond to emergencies during non-business hours.

- Required to occasionally wear personal protective equipment, including respiratory protection equipment (up to SCBA). Must be able to frequently walk up and down stairs and occasionally use ladders or enter confined spaces. Must be capable of lifting and carrying objects weighing up to 50 pounds. Must have sufficient mobility, dexterity, and endurance to perform field visits. Must be able to perform chemical monitoring and emergency response activities wearing PPE.
