Reporting to the Senior Manager, H&S, the Senior Advisor, H&S is accountable to apply the Environment, Health & Safety Policy and Environmental Health & Safety Management System framework principals and assist Operating Business Units/plants to properly and effectively implement safety within their plants. This includes the development of safety procedures designed to manage tactical and program safety performance to ensure operating facilities are aware of and in-compliance with all applicable legislation and regulations, and internal policies, approvals and internal reporting.

Key accountabilities include:

- Identifies and communicates client plant support needs including programs/procedures development needs, CMS/IMP and other software use, training, consulting support and other resources to meet plant-specific safety program;
- Assesses Business Unit/Plant Safety Program; recommends appropriate plans to improve the operational effectiveness of the function and implement decided actions;
- Analyzes and identifies issues impacting operational performance and establish initiatives for continuous improvement to ensure Capital Power operations staff and Senior Management are made aware of any material safety incidents;

The Emergency Planning Coordinator will assist in the maintenance and revision of emergency plans, procedures, and protocols, the provision of training, and the development of drills and exercises at both the state and the local level. He/she will assist with the maintenance and expansion of the Department of Public Health's all-hazard emergency operation plans, including threat-based appendices, scenario-specific annexes, and plans to address the needs of individuals with access or functional needs.

That last function—the development of plans and resources to address the emergency preparedness needs of individuals with access or functional needs—will be a substantial part of the Emergency Planning Coordinator's job. He/she will also provide technical assistance to the emergency preparedness regions and coalitions with the development and revision of local and regional public health preparedness plans, and will serve on the Emergency Preparedness Bureau's team of On-Call Duty Officers to respond, on a rotating basis, to various types of public health related emergencies on a 24/7 basis.

The Emergency Preparedness Bureau is seeking an intelligent and hard-working individual with emergency preparedness experience, ideally in an organization that specializes in healthcare or public health preparedness.
