This OpCo-based position will lead the implementation of a prevention-focused health, safety and environmental program. The position will establish, execute, and deliver OpCo-specific HSE plans that support Sysco's overall HSE objectives, including security and crisis preparedness objectives. The ideal candidate is an occupational safety, transportation safety and environmental compliance subject matter expert that can clearly articulate, develop and implement HSE action plans.

Major Tasks, Key Responsibilities and Key Accountabilities

- Implement, execute, ensure compliance with Sysco's Health, Safety and Environmental policies and procedures.
- Directs development, maintenance, and achievement of goals in support of corporate and business group HSE strategic initiatives.
- Lead execution of the OpCo's annual HSE Plan, including development of expense and capital budgets needed to support these efforts.
- Supports creation of HSE goals for the site management and appropriate activity based goals for the leadership team, functional managers, and front-line supervisors to drive EHS culture, compliance, and results.
- Build capability of OpCo resources to support implementation of HSE initiatives.
- Lead an OpCo-wide system to identify and evaluate hazards (risks), and implement effective controls (corrective solutions).
- Lead incident investigation process, including cause analysis and identification of corrective action plans.
- Interface with regulatory bodies (OSHA, DOT, EPA, State/Local Regulators).
- Facilitate the completion of an OpCo-wide annual HSE training plan.
- Participate in formal HSE reviews of existing equipment modifications, new equipment purchases, and changes in site processes.
- Ensure that required regulatory permits are acquired, that reports are submitted to regulatory agencies, and any site permit conditions (e.g. recordkeeping, PSM, storm water, special waste, etc.) are met.
- Achieve annual targets for incident frequency, severity and related cost reductions.
- Demonstrate solid employee relations experience, interpersonal and verbal/written communication skills.
- Display strong problem solving, organizational and analytical skills.
- Demonstrate professional maturity and ability to act as a change leader.
- Creates and facilitates HSE engagement through HSE teams and committees needed to accomplish the established targets and objectives for the year.
- Drives and promotes zero incident HSE culture throughout the site.
- Support execution of OpCo's Sysco Emergency Preparedness Plan procedures and policies.
- Support security initiatives for asset protection (physical and personnel).
